THIS IS A DECISION MAKING MEETING

Purpose of this meeting:

The purpose of the meeting is as follows:

- CYLC will provide an update on the CYU#1 Claim and the Taepadhighi Native Title Group's progress against the Federal Court ordered timetable.
- Taepadhighi Native Title Group members will **CONSIDER** anthropological and legal advice regarding the proposed group description (families in the group). Attendees will **DISCUSS** and **MAKE DECISIONS** about the Taepadhighi Native Title Group Description (apical ancestors) list for the CYU#1 Claim. IF A DECISION IS NOT REACHED BY TRADITIONAL OWNERS, A DECISION MAY BE MADE BY THE FEDERAL COURT.
- Taepadhighi Native Title Group members will **CONSIDER** anthropological and legal advice regarding the common boundary between Taepadhighi and Atampaya Native Title Groups within the Bertiehaugh lease area. The common boundary forms the administrative Prescribed Body Corporate (PBC) boundary post determination. IF A DECISION IS NOT REACHED BY TRADITIONAL OWNERS, A DECISION WILL BE MADE BY THE FEDERAL COURT.
- Attendees will **DISCUSS** and **MAKE DECISIONS** about the proposed Taepadhighi Native Title Group Boundary Description (within the CYU#1 claim area shown on the map below).

The above steps are critical to progress a determination of native title for Taepadhighi Native Title Group in the CYU#1 Claim.

If agreement on the boundary and group description for the Taepadhighi Native Title Group **is not** made at this meeting, CYLC will provide a broad overview of next steps, including a potential delay of the proposed determination of native title for the Taepadhighi Native Title Group which is **currently scheduled for October 2022**.

A CYLC lawyer, anthropologist and Consultant Anthropologist will attend this meeting. **It is very important Taepadhighi Native Title Group members attend this meeting, because decisions will be made which are about group membership and the common boundary between Atampaya and Taepadhighi.** If you would like to discuss this meeting further, including to confirm whether you should attend this meeting, please call CYLC on **1800 623 548** to discuss.
