3. Detailing the process required to advance the proposed Wuthathi Sea Claim;
 - Commissioning research for and preparation of connection material
 - Preliminary investigation of tenure
 - Further information and pre-authorisation meeting(s)
 - Claim authorisation meeting
4. Protecting Wuthathi native title interests in relation to overlapping Claim areas; and
5. Nominating of key people to form a Working Group with other Claimant Groups, speak on behalf of the Wuthathi People, become respondent parties to Torres Strait Regional Seas Claim Part C (QUD227/2022) and become named as Applicants in the proposed Wuthathi Sea Claim
