Kunjen Olkol Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014)

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold Native Title rights and interests within the Kunjen Olkol Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014) subject to the proposed grant of Exploration Permit for Minerals (EPMs) 28670, 28704, 28705, 28706 and 28748 held by BMAX Holdings Pty Ltd.

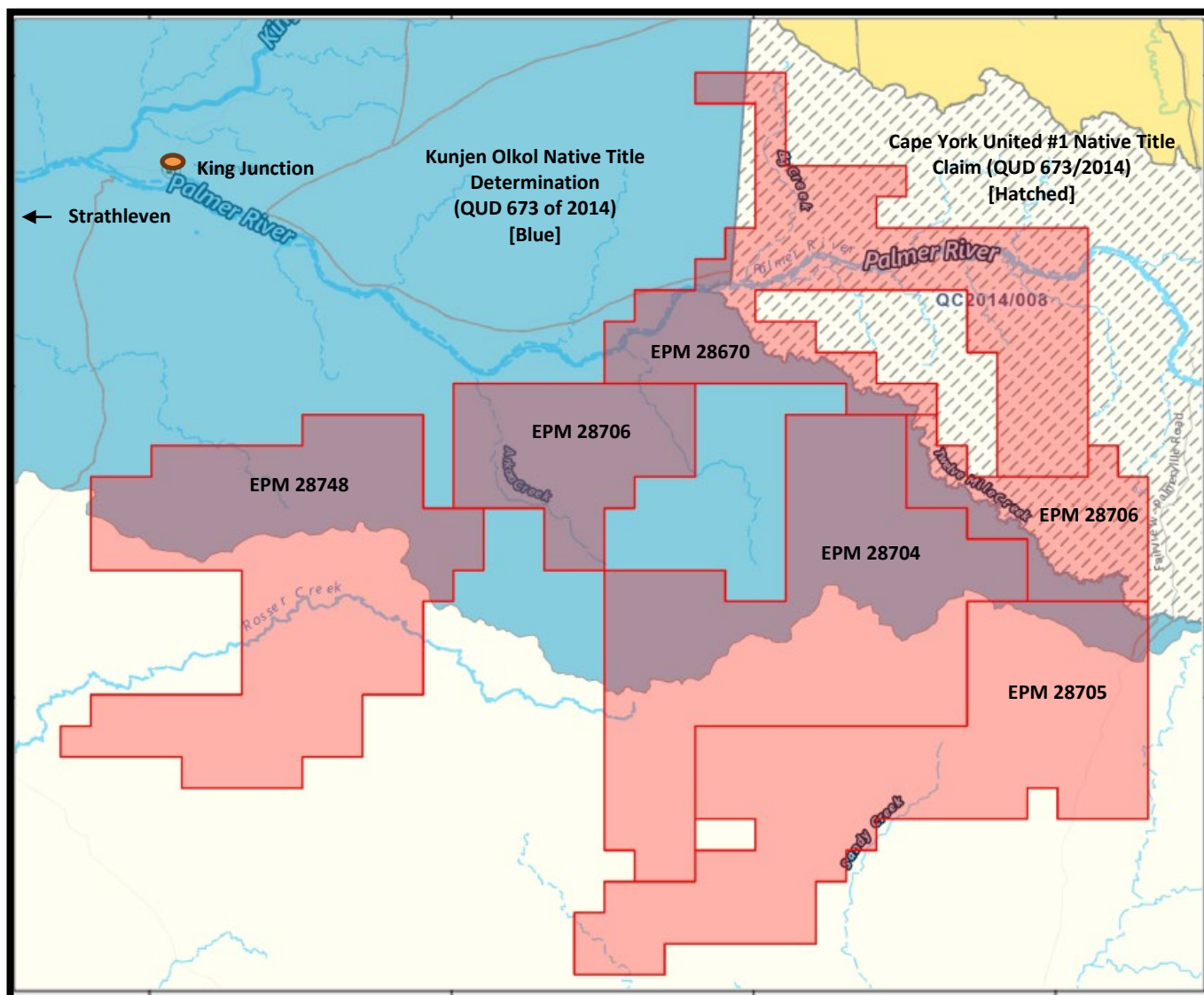
The Explorer has commenced full enquiry proceedings with the National Native Title Tribunal (NNTT) with a view to receiving a determination that the expedited procedure applies to EPMs 28670, 28704, 28705, 28706 and 28748.

On 20 December 2024, CYLC facilitated a meeting to discuss the NNTT's full enquiry process and options available to progress this matter. At this meeting, it was agreed that the Native Title Holders would attend a meeting in January 2025 to discuss the progression of the matter.
